RESOLUTION CONSENTING TO THE PROPOSED NORTHEAST WATER QUALITY MANAGEMENT (WQM) PLAN AMENDMENT

WHEREAS, the Pequannock River Basin Regional Sewerage Authority desires to provide for the orderly development of wastewater facilities to provide sewer service within its District; and

WHEREAS, the New Jersey Department of Environmental Protection (NJDEP) requires that proposed wastewater treatment and conveyance facilities and wastewater treatment service areas, as well as related subjects, conform with an approved WQM Plan; and

WHEREAS, the NJDEP has established the WQM Plan amendment procedure through the WQMP Rules at N.J.A.C7:15-3.5 as the method of incorporating unplanned facilities and previously unapproved sewer use areas into a WQM Plan; and

WHEREAS, a proposed WQM Plan Amendment to the Northeast Water Quality Management Plan (WQMP) noticed in the New Jersey Register on December 16, 2019 for incorporation of Lot 10, Block 12 in the Borough of Riverdale into the approved sewer service area of the Borough of Riverdale, the Pequannock River Basin Regional Sewerage Authority and the Pequannock, Lincoln Park and Fairfield Sewerage Authority (aka the Two Bridges Sewerage Authority) for inclusion within the Morris County Wastewater Management Plan (WMP) has been prepared by Mianecki Consulting Engineers on behalf of the Borough of Riverdale;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED on this 19th day of February, 2020 by the governing body of the Pequannock River Basin Regional Sewerage Authority that:

- The Pequannock River Basin Regional Sewerage Authority hereby consents to the WQM Amendment to the Northeast Water Quality Management Plan as publicly noticed on December 16, 2019 prepared by Mianecki Consulting Engineers for the purpose of incorporation of Lot 10, Block 12 in the Borough of Riverdale, Morris County, New Jersey into the approved sewer service area of the Morris County Wastewater Management Plan.
- 2. This consent shall be submitted to the NJDEP in accordance with N.J.A.C7:15-3.5(g)6.
- 3. This Resolution shall take effect as provided by law.
