WHEREAS. the Authority has determined that the value of the professional services will exceed \$17,500; and,

WHEREAS, the professional consultant named below has completed and submitted a Business Entity Disclosure Certification, which certifies that the firm has not made any reportable contributions to a political or candidate committee represented by an Autlority member in the previous one year, and that the contract will prohibit the firm from making any reportable contribution through the term of the contract and a C.271 Political Contribution Disclosure Form; and

WHEREAS, the Business Disclosure Entity Certification, the C.271 Political Contribution Disclosure Form, and the Determination of Value has been placed on file with this resolution.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Pequannock River Basin Regional

Sewerage Authority in the State of New Jersey on this 17th day of February, 2016. as follows:

The Authority does hereby name and designate Ferraioli, Wielkotz, Cerullo & Cuva, P.A.

of Pompton Lakes, New Jersey as Authority Auditor to provide auditing services as required, and

subject to the requirements of the Local Public Contracts Law, the Chairman is authorized to

execute an agreement therewith for the provision of such service. This contract is awarded for

the provision of professional services pursuant to N.J.S.A. 40A:11-5.

The Secretary is authorized and directed to cause a copy of this Rescaution to be

published in the official newspaper of the Authority concerning the appointment of the aforesaid

auditor within ten (10) days of the date hereof. The aforesaid firm shall be paid from funds

appropriated for these purposes in accordance with the duly adopted budget of the Authority, the

General Bond Resolution of July 15, 1986 and all supplements thereto, and other implementing

resolutions of the Authority. An Agreement for services shall be on file and available for

inspection by members of the public in accordance with law.
